| Keeping our Seniors Safe | Inspector Russ Bellman and Sergeant Greg Connolly presented on Keeping our Seniors Safe. The senior population is the fastest-growing age group, with nearly five million seniors residing in Canada with that number expected to double by 2031. Currently seniors represent 12% of York Region's population but are expected to increase to 21% by 2031 with most residing in the southern parts of the Region including Richmond Hill, Markham and Vaughan. Community focus is the cornerstone of success with many initiatives in place including crime prevention through community engagement, victim support through community partnerships, volunteerism, diversity and inclusion, communications and public trust and confidence. The York Regional Police respond to approximately 500 calls per month from seniors. Common crimes against seniors include physical and sexual assault, financial assault, thefts and neglect. Often seniors are dependent on their abusers with over 90% of the abusers being a family member. Liaising with the community, creating awareness of senior safety and creating an ability for seniors to easily connect with police along with collaborative partnerships are the most effective way to work together to keep seniors safe in our community. |

The reward will expire after a period of one year. If there is an investigative need to extend the availability of the reward beyond one year, the Chief of Police will seek the approval of the Board in a subsequent Board report. |
