Resolution on Missing and Murdered Aboriginal Women and Girls

At the Annual General Meeting of the Canadian Association of Police Governance (CAPG) last month, the York Regional Police Services Board put forward an emergency resolution that the CAPG call upon the Federal government to hold a public inquiry into the missing and murdered Aboriginal women and girls. Crime Rate in York Region

The overall crime rate in York Region increased by 8.6 percent during the first half of 2015 as compared to the first half of 2014. The rate of crimes against persons increased by 12.4 percent during that same period, and the rate of property crimes increased by 11.3 percent. Decreases were seen in drug violations, violations causing death and other Criminal Code Traffic Violations. The overall clearance rate decreased slightly to 62.5 percent.

Semi-Annual Report on Public Complaints

There was a 38 percent increase in public complaints against police officers for the same time period last year. Eighty complaints were filed with the Office of the Independent Police Review Director (OIPRD) against 95 members of the Service. Thirty-eight complaints related to police procedures, five complaints related to physical assault, 16 related to verbal abuse, seven related to misuse of authority and 14 related to policy/service.
