Respect in the Workplace Policy

The Board amended its Respect in the Workplace Policy to reflect changes to the *Occupational Health and Safety Act*. The changes revise the definition of workplace harassment to include workplace sexual harassment, and the new changes also impose new duties on employers to ensure an appropriate investigation is conducted where there is an incident or complaint of harassment. The Chief of Police will be required to report annually to the Board on the review of its processes and on the implementation of the Board's policy.

2015 Police Annual Report

The Board received the 2015 York Regional Police Annual Report. The Report profiles the accomplishments from the previous year. It includes a summary of high-profile investigations, information on community engagement and crime prevention programs, a feature on officers and projects, organization and individual awards, statistical reporting and the 2015 Business Plan accomplishments.

State of Infrastructure Report

The Board received the 2015 State of Infrastructure report for York Regional Police. The report provides detailed information on asset infrastructure and provides an overall assessment of how well York Regional Police assets are achieving their objectives and whether they meet both current and future demands. A grade of A was received for the overall assessment. This assessment reflects capital projects which include the Training Facility being built in the Town of East Gwillimbury and the new #1 District headquarters. The grades are based on reliability, condition and capacity of infrastructure assets including Facilities, Information Technology, Fleet, Telecommunications and specialized equipment.

Community Policing Survey

As part of the 2017-2019 Business Planning process, a community survey was disseminated to the citizens in York Region. Ninety-four percent of the respondents indicated satisfaction with the police. Close to nine in ten respondents thought that they were receiving good value for their tax dollars in terms of policing and 95% of respondents had confidence in York Regional Police. Areas for improvement include more police visibility and more communication with respect to
