#### Volunteer of the Year Award

Chair Frank Scarpitti and Chief Eric Jolliffe presented Auxiliary Superintendent Lynn Symons with the Volunteer of the Year Award for her commitment and dedication as a volunteer with York Regional Police for 35 years. Lynn was a graduate of the very first Auxiliary class in May 1981. She was among 24 other members and is one of two that is still with the unit today. Lynn has demonstrated leadership and teamwork as she has risen through the ranks of the unit, from Constable to Sergeant and ultimately Superintendent. Auxiliary Superintendent Symons plays a key role in events such as Halloween in the Village and Holidays in the Village. She opens the Auxiliary General Meetings each month and performs Master of Ceremonies for Auxiliary Recruit Graduation Ceremonies and social events. She provides guidance and leadership to the new generation of Auxiliary members. The Board and the Executive Command Team thanked her for her many years of volunteer service.

# 2015 Use of Force Statistics for York Regional Police

The Chief reported on the 2015 Use of Force statistics for York Regional Police. Police officers are authorized to use a range of use of force options in the course of their duties. A Use of Force Report must be completed each time an officer uses a use of force option. The Use of Force report is a province-wide standardized method of collecting information by individual police services. The use of force figures increased in 2015. The Chief's report indicates that many of the increases can be attributable to more incidents regarding the humane dispatch of animals, a change to the Conducted Energy Weapon reporting requirements and also a higher number of suspects with weapons and edged-weapons. Some of the figures in the report are:

- 293 calls for police service resulted in a Use of Force report a 56 percent increase from 2014
- 429 Use of Force reports were filed involving 457 officers 59 percent increase from last year
- Firearms were pointed at a person 162 times in 2015 compared with 125 times in 2014
- Conducted Energy Weapons were used a total of 65 times in 2015 compared with 21 times in 2014
- 33 percent of use of force incidents occurred on a roadway and 47 percent occurred between 6:00pm and 6:00am.
